Decency of clothing

The population of Israel, Palestine and many other countries is divided concerning their expectations for the decency of clothing in public places. Each religious group has its own interpretation, what is “decent clothing”.

This diagram gives a statistical answer, how strongly erotic is each part of the human body. The data is based on the answers of non-religious heterosexual men (for woman’s body) and homosexual men (for man’s body) in a survey that is available here:

A politically significant finding in this survey is that the face and fingers are regarded as more erotic than a person’s hair or forearms. This finding may contest the logical coherence of such dress codes, which allow showing one’s face and fingers, while requiring that one’s hair and forearms must be covered.
